PRAYER MEETING WITH A NEW FLAVOR AND A WONDERFUL PURPOSE!

Starting April 18, each Prayer Meeting will focus on one of the 28 Fundamental Beliefs of the Seventh-day Adventist Church. They will be addressed in the sequence they are listed in our official documents.

Your leaders invite all of you to join the study group and enjoy exploring these foundations of our faith. The benefits will enrich your relationship with our God and give you a confidence in your knowledge of His purpose for your life. We will use the Bible only as our study resource. While others are available and often rewarding, it is our hope that as we progress through each of the subjects that each of us will become very familiar with God's statements on them and be able to cite those authoritative texts that support our understanding of God's will on each of them.

Our plan is to start each discussion by giving each participant the opportunity to suggest three texts that state our belief on the subject for the week. The Holy Scriptures #1
